



Please be sure to check your child's grades on parent portal the first six weeks ends on September 20th. Don't forget that you can set up alerts on parent portal for missing assignments and/or failing grades.



PICK UP PROCEDURES

Junior high parents with a 6th or 7th grader (but no intermediate students) are asked to pull into a parking spot on the west end of the parking lot marked with the red box below. PLEASE FIND A PARKING SPOT. THERE IS NO PICK-UP LINE IN FRONT OF THE JUNIOR HIGH BUILDING.

Parents with an 8th grader only will pick their student up in the high school parking lot noted in the blue box. At dismissal, 8th graders will walk through the cafeteria area and exit the doors to the right of the high school flag poles. Eighth grade parents who also have a 6th or 7th grader can pick up all students in the area marked by the red box in the junior high lot.

Junior high parents with a 6th, 7th or 8th grader AND an intermediate student will park in the area marked by the green box below.

The bus lane is reserved for buses only in the afternoon. Please DO NOT pull in front of the junior high or intermediate building and block the flow of traffic, pull into a parking space.

At all times, please use caution and patience in the school parking lots and school zones. Please be mindful of the crosswalk and don't park on top of it. We appreciate you helping us keep our students safe when arriving and leaving school. Thank you for your patience and understanding.







CELL PHONE POLICY

Students are allowed to bring cell phones to school. They are allowed to listen to music and play games on their cell phones during lunch and after school. **Students must keep cell phones out of sight and turned off (not on silent) during the school day.** Please reinforce this rule with your child so they are well aware.



Also, please do not allow your child to call or text you from school using their cell phone for any reason, including to come pick them up when they do not feel well.

Proper procedure is to report to Nurse Alexander and allow her to use her training to make that determination. Misuse will result in confiscation of the cell phone and the parent will be required to come pick up the phone. If the student continues to misuse their cell phone, the student will be required to check their cell phone into the office each morning.

DRESS CODE POLICY

Please be familiar with the student dress code to help us proactively head off any issues before they arise.


A few things to be aware of regarding the dress code are:



- Hair must be a natural color. No Mohawks, faux-hawks, or designs in hair.
- Pants should not have cuts or holes above fingertip length and skin should not be seen.
- Skirts/shorts/athletic shorts need to be fingertip length.
- Tight-fitting clothing, such as yoga pants. tights, and leggings, must have a loose-fitting outer layer that is long enough to hit the top of both the front and back of the thighs.
- House shoes/house slippers/blankets/pillows are not allowed.




